Research Questions

A good way to start historical research is to ask when, where, who. Here are a few of these types of questions to like this – can you answer them?

When was our character alive? When did they die?	
Where did they live? Where did they travel to?	
Who accused our character of a crime? Who did our character commit a crime against?	
The next step is to ask, "What happened?" Try to work out the story of your character's life, being accused of a crime and whether they were found guilty or innocent. To help you, answer the questions below.	
What happened in our character's life? What happened when they were accused of a crime?

Is it certainly true if it comes from Wikipedia?	
Is it certainly true if it was said in a newspaper?
