Zoom Catch up 9:00 – 6ZO 9:30 – 6GS 10:00 – 6MA	Your teacher will zoom with you this morning to explain the week's learning and answer any questions you might have. You will be sent a link to your school email account this morning. Please log into the Zoom promptly.
Times table practice (15 mins)	As you know, we are always encouraging you to learn your times tables up to 12x12. That means you have 144 times tables to learn. Or does it? Actually you really only need to learn 38 times tables. Reading (30 mins)	Today, you are going to read the rest of Chapter 15: Home. While you are reading, make a note of the key events that happen between William and his Mum. What does she say to him? How does he feel? You will need this for tomorrow's lesson.  Pink Group: Complete the same task as above but for the extract that you have been given.
Maths (1 hour)	Today you will be applying your knowledge of division to solve problems.  Complete the True or False activity on the website. Watch this video: <a href="https://vimeo.com/490691954">https://vimeo.com/490691954</a> . Then complete the worksheet.  Challenge: Complete at least one of the challenge questions from the link on the website.  Pink Group: Today you will be working on short division calculations (3 digits divided by 1 digit). Open the link on the website to watch Miss Andrews' model of how to use the formal written method for short division (bus stop).  Complete Questions 1, 2 & 4 on the worksheet using the formal written method for short division (bus stop) where you can.
English (1 hour)	Today you will be revising how to use commas to separate clauses. Follow the lesson carefully and click the video links for a reminder on each type of clause. When you have finished, read the extract provided from Goodnight Mister Tom and annotate the different types of clauses that you can see within the text. Pink group: Today you will be focusing on main and subordinate clauses. Follow the lesson carefully and click the video links. Task: Label the main and subordinate clauses in the sentences.
Geography (45 mins)	Today you will be learning about the different regions and counties in England. Start by labelling the countries and capital cities of the UK.  Task: Write some clues down for someone else in your household to guess the different counties on the map.  Challenge: Which county do we live in? Can you find out what the biggest and smallest county is in England? Which county has the most people living in it?
Spelling and Handwriting (30 mins)	In today's lesson we are going to have another look at suffixes – tion – cian –sion –ssion. We will think about what adding suffixes does to root words and how to spell them correctly.
