PE 9:15 – 10:15	Use the same link that you were sent last week for PE. Make sure you log in on time and have your camera switched on so that the PE staff can check you are exercising safely. Remember to wear appropriate clothing, clear a space so that you can move around easily and have a drink of water with you.
Zoom catch up 6ZO – 10:30 6GS – 11:00 6MA – 11:30	Your class teacher will email you a zoom link so that you can catch up with your class and ask your teacher any questions about the work you've been doing.
Maths 1 hour	<p>Today you are going to practise converting fractions to decimals. Complete the True or False question to start to see how much you can remember.</p> <p>Watch the video as an introduction https://vimeo.com/491237616 and complete the questions on the worksheet.</p> <p>Challenge: Complete the 'Matching Fractions, Decimals and Percentages' interactive game or the printable match up version: http://shorturl.at/jyzI1</p> <p>Pink Group: Today you will be practising your short division calculations (4 digits divided by 1). Watch Miss Andrews' bus stop method model video again or look again at your work on this from yesterday if you need to. Complete the 10 questions on the worksheet to help practise the short division bus stop method. For an extra challenge and something fun, try the short division game. You can print the resources (pages 1 – 4 ONLY) or draw your own examples using pages 1 – 4 to help you.</p>
Reading 30 mins	<p>Today, you are going to read Chapter 16: The Search. When you have finished reading, write your responses onto your class Padlet. You may need to copy and paste the link for your class into an internet browser. Here you can make a note of your likes, dislikes, questions and connections for the chapter. Remember to be respectful and polite in your responses. RE 45mins	<p><u>Focus: Christianity</u></p> <p>Today you are going to be completing your last RE lesson on 'messages'. In this lesson you are going to watch videos that tell some of the significant stories about Jesus. Each of these stories will have a message of its own. You will need to make notes so that you can use them in Task 2.</p> <p>For Task 2, you will need to agree/disagree with a statement about Jesus' messages from the Bible.</p>
