Maths 1 hour	<p>Today you will be continuing your work on converting fractions to decimals to secure your knowledge even further. Watch the video input https://vimeo.com/491970120 and complete the questions on the worksheet.</p> <p>Challenge: Complete the True or False Question. Can you write your own example and show your workings too?</p> <p>Pink Group: Today you are going to practise your short division further – this time working with remainders. Watch the video https://vimeo.com/492054148 to help you get started. Complete Questions 1 - 3 and Question 5 as a challenge.</p>
English 1 hour	<p>In English today, you will be undertaking some research into what it would have been like to have been evacuated. You will need to watch the videos and recordings to find out the information and then record your findings onto the mind map. Remember, we are going to be writing in role as evacuees so try to use the information that you find out to help you get into character.</p> <p>Challenge: Conduct your own research into life as an evacuee to really develop your character in depth. Could you find out what life was like in the 1940s and what sorts of things you would have been up to?</p>
PE 1:30 – 2:30	<p>Use the same link that you were sent last week for PE. Make sure you log in on time and have your camera switched on so that the PE staff can check you are exercising safely. Remember to wear appropriate clothing, clear a space so that you can move around easily and have a drink of water with you.</p>

Use this app to practise further or you may prefer to use Times Tables Rockstars, then please complete the worksheets. Set up a timer and see if you can beat your scores. You can print the worksheet off more than once if you want to try and compete against yourself.</p> <p>Pink group: This week, I would like you to focus on just the 6s, 7s and 8 times tables. These are some of the trickier questions. Keep practising and try your best. All your teachers want to see is some improvement.</p>
