Maths (1 hour)	<p><i><u>L.O. I am learning to multiply and divide by 2, 4, and 8.</u></i></p> <p>In this lesson we will be practising our 2, 4, and 8 times table. There is a challenge to try afterwards if you would like to push yourselves! English (1 hour)	<p><i><u>L.O. To build scientific vocabulary to describe healthy snacks</u></i></p> <p>In this lesson, children will sort healthy and unhealthy snacks. We will discuss a healthy diet and what foods make up a healthy diet. Children will think about what makes a snack healthy.
