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Spelling and Handwriting 15 mins	To finish your spelling revision this week, you can put your knowledge of year 5/6 words to the test in the form of a game (or three!). Reading 30 mins	In today's lesson, you are going to put your reading skills to the test in a reading comprehension. We have included the chapter you need from yesterday's lesson on the webpage so you do not have to go back and forth. The questions ask about William, Tom and how people are dealing with the death of a friend. Answer each question in FULL sentences and use evidence from the text when you can.
Maths 1 hour	Today you will be continuing with your work on adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators. Watch the video <u>https://vimeo.com/471344877</u> to help you with your work today. Complete the 'Adding and Subtracting Fractions 2' worksheet. Don't forget to mark your work! Challenge: Try the True or False activity. Can you write your own explanation and workings using the answer you have been given? Pink Group: Today you are going to learn how to convert improper fractions to mixed numbers. Watch the video <u>https://vimeo.com/498991812</u> as this will help you with today's work and then complete questions 1 – 4. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet. You can try question 5 if you'd like an extra challenge too!
English 1 hour	Today you are going to plan your informal letter. Firstly, read the example letter to give you an idea of what your final piece should look like. You may want to underline the key words and phrases that you could magpie for your own piece of writing. Before you begin planning, have a look at the word bank and glossary to help you think of some ideas. For each paragraph, think carefully about what emotion you are going to include and the vocabulary you will plan in. Use the planning template to help you.
