Friday 12th February 2021	
Reading 30 mins	As we come towards the end of the Goodnight Mister Tom, you are going to be reading one of the final chapters in two parts. Today your task is reading the second half of Chapter 22 which is called 'Grieving'. In this half of the chapter you will continue to see how William deals with the death of Zach as well as the impact that this has on Tom. Challenge: If you could ask the author anything about this book, what would you ask?
Maths 1 hour	Today you will be recapping what you already know about adding mixed numbers. Complete the True or False Starter Activity to see what you can remember! Watch the video https://vimeo.com/471345176 to help you with the work today. Complete the 'Add Mixed Numbers' worksheet. Don't forget to mark your work too! Challenge: Friday's Fraction Addition Challenge! To complete this challenge, you will need 5 pieces of plain paper and a pair of scissors. Pink Group: Today you are going to learn how to convert mixed numbers to improper fractions. Watch the video https://vimeo.com/500361175 as this will help you with today's work and then complete questions 1 – 4. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet. You can try question 5 if you'd like an extra challenge too!
English 1 hour	Today you are going to write your informal letter home in role as an evacuee. Try your best to make the letter as emotive as possible to show your loved ones that you are writing to back home to know how much you are missing them. There is some publishing paper for you to download and use or if you want to, you may want to make your own tea-stained paper! Your teachers are looking forward to seeing your letters by the end of today!
History 1 hour	Today you are going to be learning about the British fighter plane: The Spitfire. Read the information and watch the videos. Then, complete a poster, leaflet, PowerPoint presentation or information pack about the history of the Spitfire. If you finish early, there are some fun WW2 activities to do. Pick as few or as many as you would like to do!
Celebration assembly 2:00	There will be a whole school assembly with Mr Howard. Mr Howard will send out the link to the assembly at some point during the day before 2pm. This will be sent to your school email account. Please make sure that you are on mute, that you arrive promptly and are sat sensibly ready for assembly to begin.
