Spelling 20 minutes	In spelling today, you will focus on some of the Year 1 and Year 2 tricky spelling words. English 1 hour	In today's lesson you will be revising how to use capital letters and full stops. <u>Follow the power point by clicking on the play icon and pressing the space bar to work through the steps in the lesson.</u> Work carefully through the PowerPoint Lesson as there are tasks along the way as you complete the lesson.
