Music (45 mins) 5AS/5CT: 9.15am 5AE/5MT: 10am	We will be having class music lessons. A link to the lesson will be sent to you early in the morning, so please check your emails. Please log on promptly. You will be told in advance if you need anything for the lesson.
Spelling (30 minutes)	<u>LO: I am learning to use strategies to practise my spellings.</u> Today, you will be revising the spelling rule you learned yesterday. You will then be using look, cover, write check to practise these spellings. All the resources you will need are in today's folder in the school website.

Maths (1 hour)	<u>LO: I am learning to add and subtract.</u> Today you will apply your learning of addition and subtraction and money to answer the worded problems on the worksheet, which can be found in today's folder on the website along with the answers to mark your work. Remember to look for key words to help you for example: altogether and total show you need to add and difference or left over will show you need to subtract.
