Times table practice (15 mins)	<u>LET THE BATTLE COMMENCE!</u> <i>For one day only!</i> Year 6 boys vs. Year 6 girls Who will come out victorious? Remember, at least 15 minutes practise is required but you may want to do more if you're feeling competitive...
Reading (30 mins)	This half term, we are going to reading 'Carrie's War'. Open the reading lesson resource and think about the questions; you can jot down your answers if you want to. Listen to the first part of the story https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1--ks2-episode1-carries-war/zm77gwx Make some notes about the characters in the story so far. Try to work out the relationships between each character. There is a template on the website for you. Pink group: Please find a template in the pink folder which has already been started for you.
Maths (1 hour)	This week we are going to continue learning about fractions. What can you remember about adding mixed numbers? Complete the True or False Warm Up activity to link to the end of week 6 learning. Watch the video https://vimeo.com/471389642 to help with your learning today. Complete the 'Add Fractions' worksheet and mark your work using the answer sheet. Challenge: Complete at least one of the three mixed number and improper fraction challenge cards. Could you also write your own 'would you rather?' question to send to a friend (or teacher!) and challenge them? Look at the challenge card for more information on how to do this! Pink Group: Today we are going to be recapping counting in fractions. This will help with some of your other Maths lessons this week. Watch the video https://vimeo.com/506082065 to help you get started. Complete questions 1 – 5 on the 'Count in fractions' worksheet. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet.
English (1 hour)	In English this week you will be finding out about the life of Captain Sir Tom Moore in order to write a biography of his life. Today you will look at what a biography is, find out about the key events in Captain Tom's life and write the introduction for your biography. We will be researching, drafting and publishing a section each day, so think carefully about how you would like to publish your writing. There is a publishing page and images of Captain Tom on the website for you to use or you could create your own publishing page!
Science (45 mins)	Today you are going to learning about light and dark. The next half of your lesson will teach you how light helps us to see things.
