PE 9:15 – 10:15	Use the same link that you were sent last week for PE. Make sure you log in on time and have your camera switched on so that the PE staff can check you are exercising safely. Remember to wear appropriate clothing, clear a space so that you can move around easily and have a drink of water with you.
Zoom catch up 6ZO – 10:30 6GS – 11:00 6MA - 11:30	Your teacher will zoom with you this morning to explain the week's learning and answer any questions you might have. You will be sent a link to your school email account this morning. Please log into the Zoom promptly.
Maths (1 hour)	Today you will be subtracting fractions again to help with your mathematical fluency! Start by completing the True or False Warm Up activity. Have a go at completing the calculation without exchanging too by converting the mixed numbers into improper fraction – it's good to practise! Watch the video https://vimeo.com/475425649 to introduce and help with your work today. Complete the 'Subtract Fractions' worksheet. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet too! Challenge: Continue working through the subtracting fractions challenge sheet. Can you complete at least 2 more? Don't forget to mark your work too! Pink Group: Today you will be continuing to show what you know about comparing and ordering fractions. Today you need to complete pages 5 & 6 of the 'Comparing and Ordering Fractions' worksheet. You will need to draw the circles and bar models yourself if you do not have access to a printer. Don't forget to mark your work using the answers on pages 7 & 8 of the same document.
Reading (30 mins)	Today you are going to be listening to the next part of the story. In this part of the story, Carrie and Nick's mother visit them in Wales. Carrie is worried that Nick is going to tell their mother how cruel Mr Evans is. There are some questions for you to think about whilst listening to this next part of the story. You can jot down the answers to them if you want to or might want to just discuss them with someone in your household. Everything you need is on the reading document you can download from the website.
French (30 mins)	Today you will be learning some new French vocabulary by reading a French poem called <i>Dans Paris</i> . Follow the link shared with you. You will see a Google Slides presentation on the Google Drive and then you can complete the activities. Challenge: Can you present the words you have stored in your vocabulary bank in a different way? A Dans Paris poem poster for example?
RE (45 mins)	In RE lessons this half term, we are going to be continuing to learn about Christianity. The focus of this learning will be about one particular part of The Easter Story – the resurrection. You will think carefully about what this means and why it is important to Christians.
