

## **Remote Learning Timetable**

Please see below your lessons for today. It is up to you which order you do your lessons, however, there will be times where we will be meeting online, using Zoom. It is important that you check your emails for any Zoom links. If you are struggling, please do not worry, you will have the chance to chat with your class teacher at the catch up sessions. Move onto something else and you will always be able to go back to it.

<b>Friday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2021</b>	
Reading (30 mins)	Today you are going to be listening to the next part of 'Carrie's War'. Before you listen, can you predict what will happen when Carrie and Nick go inside the house? Listen to the end of episode 3 to jog your memories if you need to – it was left on a cliff hanger! Listen to episode 4 to see if you were right. <b>Challenge:</b> Can you storyboard the key events that have happened so far from the very beginning (episode 1-4)? You might want to get creative and turn this into a comic strip.
Maths (1 hour)	Today you will be learning how to multiply fractions by integers. Complete the True or False Warm Up activity to get started. Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/475426110">https://vimeo.com/475426110</a> before you start to introduce and help you with your work today. Complete the 'Multiply Fractions by Integers' worksheet and mark your work using the answer sheet. <b>Challenge:</b> Can you apply today's learning to these worded problems? See how many you can do! Don't forget to check your answers too! <b>Pink Group:</b> Today you will be continuing your work on fractions by adding 2 or more fractions with the same denominator. Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/507468794">https://vimeo.com/507468794</a> to help with your work today. Complete questions 1 – 5 on the 'add 2 or more fractions' worksheet. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet. If you would like to practise these skills even further you can try question 6 too!
English (1 hour)	Today you will be writing the final section of your biography about the legacy Captain Sir Tom Moore has left behind. Read the information about his fundraising and take a look at his webpage: The Captain Tom Foundation. Make a note of the key events and details, then draft this section. You will probably need more than one paragraph here as there is lots to write about! Finally, finish publishing your biography and then sit back and admire your work!
History (1 hour)	Today you are going to be learning about the D-Day landings. The lesson will be shared with you in the morning. Go through the Google Slides, listen to the explanations and watch the videos. Make some notes about D-Day and then write a short diary entry in role as somebody involved in D-Day (more information is on the slides!) <b>Challenge:</b> Can you write two diary entries? One before the battle and one afterwards.
Celebration Assembly 2:00 – 2:30	Join Mr Howard's Celebration Assembly this afternoon. Make sure you are on mute and being respectful to everyone who is receiving any rewards. Good luck!
Finishing off time (30 mins)	Use this time to get any work finished from this week that you need to. If you have managed to get everything done, use this time usefully. You could do some additional times tables or spelling practise. You could start a new book. Could you use this time to develop another skill? For example: baking, sewing, painting or drawing. Let your teacher know what you chose to do!
