English (30 minutes)	<p><b><i><u>L.O. I am learning how to write complex sentences.</u></i></b> Today you will be learning about a different type of sentence - complex sentences. Complex sentences have a main clause that makes sense on its own but it also has a subordinate clause to give extra information. The subordinate clause does not make sense on its own.
