

LO: I am learning to use the suffixes –ary / -ery

1) What is the root word for these words?

Slippery **Slip** Delivery **Deliver** Recovery **Recover**

2) Finish these words by adding the suffix –ary or –ery.

Cook **Cookery** Diction **Dictionary**

Sugar **Sugary** Diet **Dietary**

3) What is the rule for using the suffix –ery?

In majority of cases, this suffix turns words into nouns for example: Scenery, bravery, bakery. Also, all these words have an obvious root word. However, the word mystery does not have a root word.

4) What is the rule for using the suffix –ary?

One rule for this suffix is that it applies to root words which are not obvious such as primary, as its root word is prime. Another rule for the suffix –ary is that it turns words into adjectives and nouns. Also, if the root word ends in an 'e' we remove the 'e' and add the suffix.
