Please see below your lessons for today. It is up to you which order you do your lessons, however, there will be times where we will be meeting online, using Zoom. Zoom Catch up 9:00 – 6ZO 9:30 – 6GS 10:00 – 6MA	Your teacher will zoom with you this morning to explain the week's learning and answer any questions you might have. You will be sent a link to your school email account this morning. Please log into the Zoom promptly.
Times table practice (15 mins)	Open the mixed multiplication board game that was shared with you on Google this morning and either play with someone else at home or on your own. If you do not have dice at home, use the online dice: https://dice.virtuworld.net/ When you are done, complete the remaining time of this session on Times Tables Rockstars.
Reading (30 mins)	Today your lesson will be shared with you on Google Slides today. In today's lesson, you will be learning to summarise. You will develop these skills by summarising key events from the section of the book that we have listened to so far.
Maths (1 hour)	Today you will be learning how to multiply fractions by fractions. Complete the True or False Warm Up activity to get started. Watch the video https://vimeo.com/476253821 before you start to introduce and help you with your work today. Complete the 'Multiply Fractions by Fractions' worksheet and mark your work using the answer sheet. Challenge: Can you apply today's learning to the fraction jigsaw puzzle challenge? Complete one of three – the choice is yours! Pink Group: Today you will be recapping how to subtract fractions. Watch the video https://vimeo.com/507527822 as it will help you with your work today and tomorrow. Complete the 'recap subtract fractions' worksheet. You may want to draw bar models to help you – it's up to you! Don't forget to use the answer sheet to mark your work.
English (1 hour)	In English this week, you will write a short narrative about Captain Sir Tom Moore. You will use what you learned about him last week to inform your story writing this week. He will be your main character, but what happens to him and other characters can be fictional. Today, you will begin by learning how to punctuate dialogue accurately. Pink Group: Today you will begin by revising how to use inverted commas. Watch the video and then complete the task. You will then start to plan a story about Captain Sir Tom Moore, using pictures to help you.
Science (45 mins)	Today you are going to learn about reflective and non-reflective materials. Watch the video, complete the tasks during the video and the end of lesson quiz: https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/which-materials-are-reflective-6cu6cc Challenge: Can you make your own quiz on reflective and non-reflective materials for a friend or family member?
Spelling and Handwriting (30 mins)	In today's lesson, you will look at words which have the letter patterns 'ph, sc and ch', which originate from the Greek language. This is called the etymology of words.
