Please see below your lessons for today. It is up to you which order you do your lessons, however, there will be times where we will be meeting online, using Zoom. Music 9:30 – 6ZO 10.15 – 6GS 11.00 – 6MA	You will be sent your link for the music lesson this morning although it is the same as last week. Make sure you arrive on time and have your microphone muted. Please be prepared to share your answers with the class and be respectful of your classmates.
Reading (30 mins)	Today we are going to be thinking about how the character's felt within this section of the story. This will be good practise for our retrieval and inference skills. You may want to re-listen to episode 4 and take some notes to refresh your memories!
Maths (1 hour)	Today you are going to learn how to divide fractions by integers. What can you remember about this? Complete the True or False Warm Up activity to get you started. Can you use a pictorial model to show your answer? Watch the video https://vimeo.com/476254074 to introduce and help you with your work today. Complete the 'Divide Fractions by Integers (1)' worksheet to show what you know. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet too! Challenge: Go back to the True or False Warm Up activity. Can you write your own example of a true or false dividing fractions by integers question and send to a friend (or teacher!) to challenge them? Pink Group: Today you will be continuing to learn how to subtract fractions and apply what you learnt yesterday too. Watch the video https://vimeo.com/507597199 to help with your work. Complete questions 1 – 5 on the 'subtract 2 fractions' worksheet. Don't forget to draw bar models to help if you need to. Try question 6 too if you would like a challenge!
English (1 hour)	In the first part of today's lesson, you will learn how to use adjectives to describe a setting. This will help you to write the opening for your narrative. You will need a pen and paper ready. Then, read the short story examples. You can use these as a model for your own story writing next lesson. Pink Group: In today's lesson, you are going to write the opening for your story about Captain Sir Tom Moore. Use the picture plan you created last lesson and the example as a model for your own writing.
Computing (1 hour)	Today you will be learning about communication in technology. In particular when we use search engines and how we as humans communicate with the computers when we need to find information. The learning sheets and links you need are all on your activity sheets.
Spelling and Handwriting (30 mins)	In this lesson, you will revise your learning about the Greek etymology of words and look at a helpful practise strategy you could use to learn new spellings.
