Maths (1 hour)	<p>Today you will be working out fractions of an amount. Start by completing the True or False Warm Up activity to get you started. Complete the 'Fraction of an amount' worksheet. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet too!</p> <p>Challenge: If you felt really successful with today's work and would like a challenge, try the 'Would You Rather' challenge – Pages 5 & 6 ONLY.</p> <p>Pink Group: Today you will be finding fractions of a set of objects. You won't have the same concrete apparatus (place value counters and base 10) to use at home but you can draw place value counters or bar models and use those to help you answers these questions.
