Maths (1 hour)	<b><u>L.O. I am learning to draw pictograms.</u></b> You are moving onto looking at pictograms. Again, this is something that you should have looked at in Year 2 but we are revisiting it. If you are feeling confident, you can move onto the pictogram challenge task rather than completing the task sheets. There are some challenging word problems for you to have a go at, so make sure you read the questions carefully or ask someone to read with you. English (45 minutes)	<b><u>L.O. I am learning to write the start of a story.</u></b> In today's lesson, you will be finishing the start of your story.
