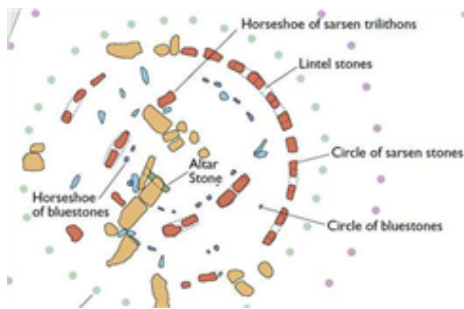

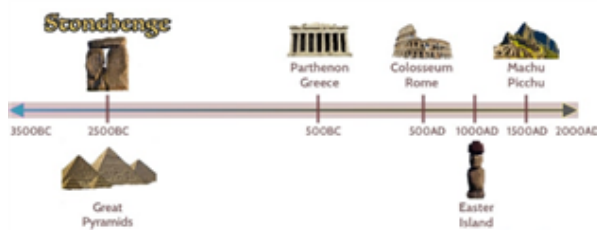

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A trilithon is a structure made up of three stones (two that support another one on top). What words can you think of that begin 'tri'?



A lintel is the block at the top. We have lintels on all our windows and doors.
