

SPELLING TIC TAC TOE

After you have read some of your book, have a go at one of the activities. When you have completed an activity, cross it off so you can try another one tomorrow.

With a computer or tablet, type it out. Open up a document to type on. Get an adult to call out the word and you type. You can then play around with the word; increase the font size, change the colour etc.	Voice record: Using a recording device (this can even be your mobile phone) spell out the word and listen back to the spelling.
With spelling flashcards (easily made by writing on cut up squares of paper) make the game pairs. Create a double set of the words that you are finding tricky. Pick up two cards at a time until they find a pair. Can you verbally spell it out?	Flip, Read, Letters and Write: Learn your spellings in 4 quick steps. Flip over a card, read it, spell out the letters and then write it down.
Spelling Puzzle: Make a home-made puzzle by writing the words in large on a piece of card.	Rainbow writing and write the word in different colours.
