

After you have read some of your book, have a go at one of the activities. When you have completed an activity, cross it off so you can try another one tomorrow.

With a computer or tablet, type it out. Open up a document to type on. Get an adult to call out the word and you type. You can then play around with the word; increase the font size, change the colour etc.	Voice record: Using a recording device (this can even be your mobile phone) spell out the word and listen back to the spelling.
<ul> <li>With spelling flashcards (easily made by writing on cut up squares of paper) make the game pairs. Create a double set of the words that you are finding tricky.</li> <li>Pick up two cards at a time until they find a pair.</li> <li>Can you verbally spell it out?</li> </ul>	Flip, Read, Letters and Write: Learn your spellings in 4 quick steps. Flip over a card, read it, spell out the letters and then write it down.
Spelling Puzzle: Make a home-made puzzle by writing the words in large on a piece of card.	Rainbow writing and write the word in different colours.
