What does SMSC stand for and why is it important?



Spiritual: You will explore this mostly in RE and some assemblies. You will explore other's beliefs, faiths and experiences and be respectful to them. You can begin to learn about yourself and others in the surrounding world as well as reflect on your thoughts. Use your imagination and creativity.

Moral: You can recognise the difference between right and wrong. You know that you must respect the law and understand the consequences. You may begin to investigate moral and ethical issues and discover what you believe through listening to others opinion and begin to give your own.

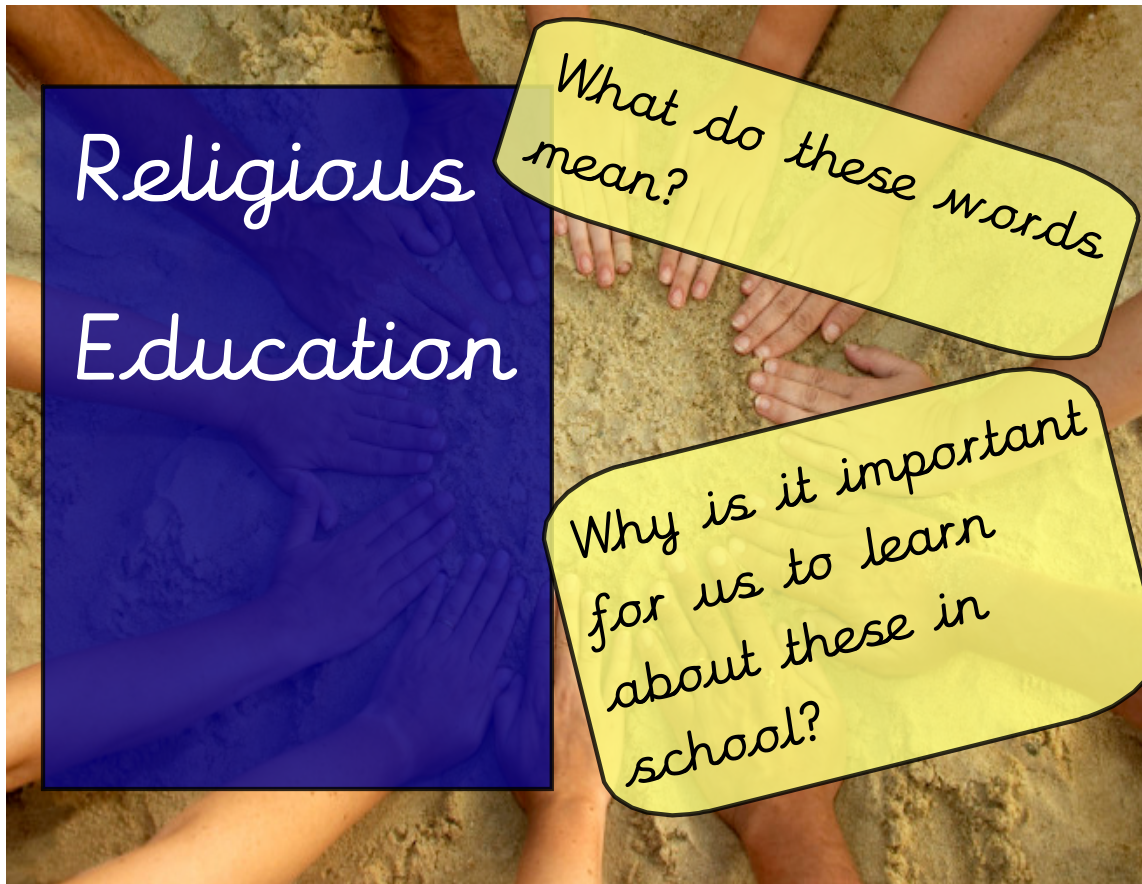
Social: In school you get to develop your social skills and communicate with people in your class. You will participate in the local community and help others for example give to charities. Volunteer, cooperate and resolve conflict. Appreciate different opinions and engage with the British values.

Cultural: You will explore different cultures and understand and appreciate differences. You will understand democracy and the British Parliamentary system. Understand, accept, respect and celebrate diversity.

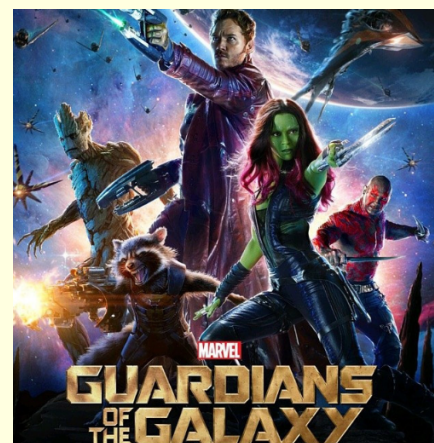
