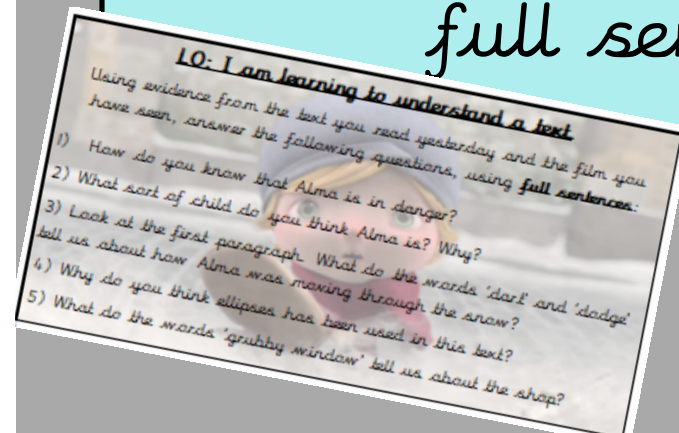

### LO: I am learning to understand a text.

Using evidence from the text you read yesterday and the film you have seen, answer the following questions, using **full sentences**:

1) How do you know that Alma is in danger?

Points you could have given include:

- the streets are deserted
- The music in the film is dramatic and gives a sense of danger
- The doll moves position
- The boy on the bike attempts to warn her
- The door opens on its own

2) What sort of child do you think Alma is? Why?

Some ideas might include:

- inquisitive as she wants to know more about the shop and ventures in
- Brave as she is all on her own and she gets trapped
- Reckless as she doesn't consider her own safety
- Happy as she skips down the street

Or your own idea if supported with relevant evidence.

3) Look at the first paragraph. What do the words 'dart' and 'dodge' tell us about how Alma was moving through the snow?

Dart and dodge mean moving quickly to avoid something. Alma was moving quickly through the snow trying to avoid being hit.

4) Why do you think ellipses has been used in this text?

Ellipses is used to build suspense. It shows where missing words are, making you imply what is happening.

5) What do the words 'grubby window' tell us about the shop?

Grubby means dirty so it tells us the shop has not been looked after by its owner;
