What does 'Good and Evil' mean

Holi is a Hindu festival which celebrates the story of prince called Prahlad who's father (the King) wanted everybody in the kingdom to worship him. Prahlad refused and worshipped Lord Vishnu instead.

The king's sister Holika, who was immune to fire, tricked her nephew Prahlad into sitting on her lap in a bonfire in order to destroy him, but because she was using her powers for evil, the plan failed and Prahlad emerged from the fire unharmed, while Holika was burnt by the flames.

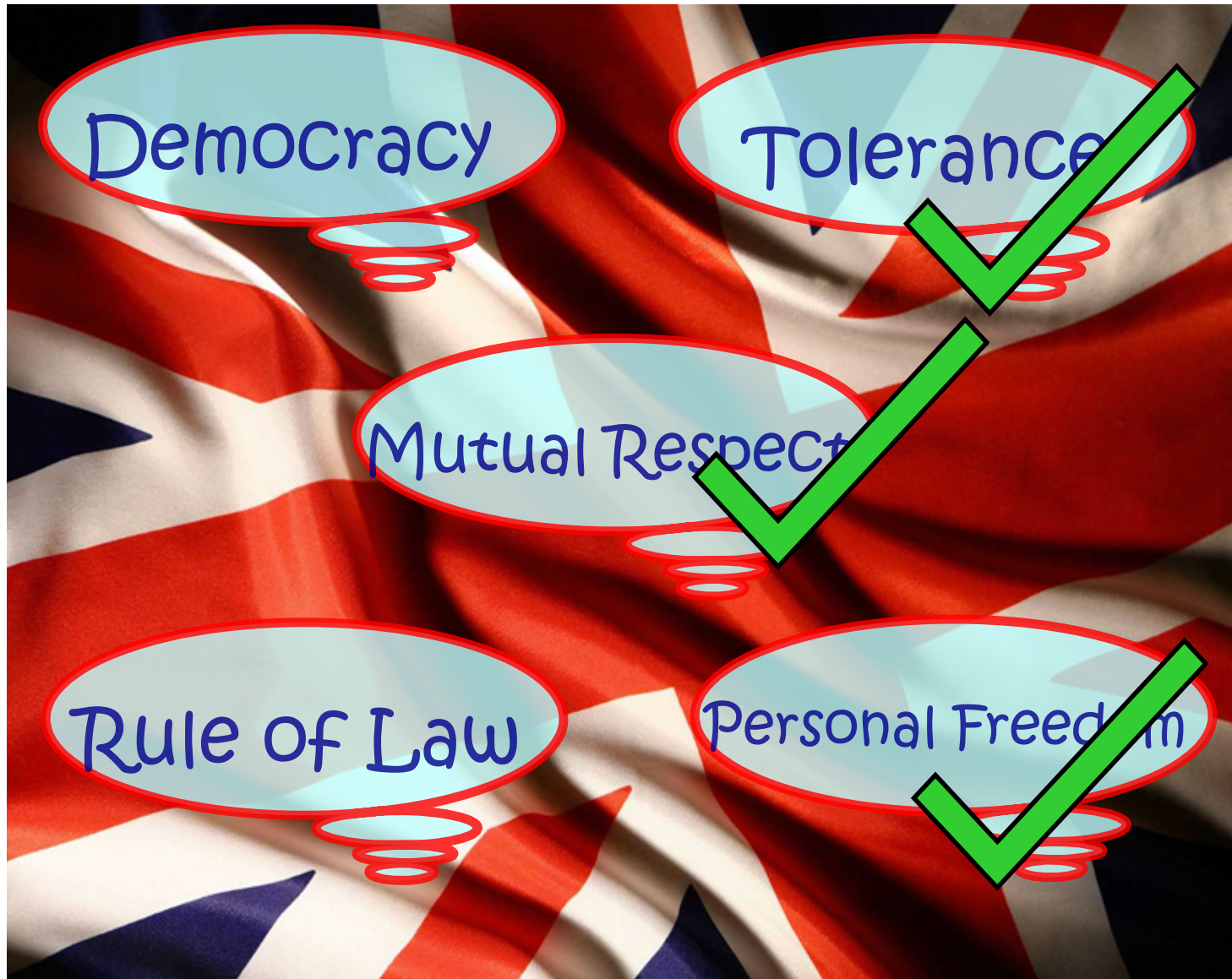
