

What does it mean to Hindus?


Hindus believe in 3 supreme gods. Lord Vishnu is one of them.


The king's sister Holika, who was immune to fire, tricked her nephew Prahlad into sitting on her lap in a bonfire in order to destroy him, but because she was using her powers for evil, the plan failed and Prahlad emerged from the fire unharmed, while Holika was burnt by the flames.




