Reading (1 hour)	<p><u>L.O. English (1 hour)	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to understand verbs.</u></p> <p>Watch and listen to the third video on this website (Activity 3) and see how many verbs (doing words) you can spot. For example, if you chose the word knocked, your sentence could be: I knocked on my friend's front door.</p> <p>If you really want to test yourself, try writing three more sentences using the present or future tense of the verbs in your list. For example: I am going to knock on my friend's front door.</p>
