Final Preparations

As mentioned in our previous letter:

We are now VERY excited about our trip to the Isle of Wight. We have worked very closely with Hampshire Outdoors, PGL, Red Funnel and Island Coaches to ensure that our children and staff are as safe as possible.

*Firstly, if your child exhibits any symptoms that could be Covid-19 related at any time during the week, including over the weekend prior to the trip, you **MUST** get a PCR test immediately and let us know the result. Over the weekend, you can email me in an emergency on head@fjslive.net and I will reply. In order to ensure that our trip is COVID free, we are asking if all children can have a lateral flow test before setting off on Monday. Thank you for your support with this. If your child has a positive lateral flow test, please contact us immediately.*

*Whilst we are on the island, if your child becomes symptomatic, they will be self-isolated in a designated room and **you will need to come and collect them** to return home for a PCR test. This is in line with the PGL Infection Control Policy and the DfE Guidance for Schools.*

Please keep an eye on the weather forecast and ensure that your child is well equipped for potentially cold and wet weather. A waterproof coat is essential. We have suggested that the children bring extra socks in case they get wet. A torch will also be handy for the evening activities.

If you are bringing medicines to the terminal, please hand them in to Mrs Errouam. Children need to have their £10 spending money packed in their bags in a named envelope or wallet/purse. We will collect this in once we've arrived at Little Canada.

We have spoken to the children this week to remind them of what they need to bring and have talked them through what to expect. If any thing else arises, please do not hesitate to contact us.
