



LO: *I am learning
to type.*

Learning to type quickly and accurately is an important skill.

- If you practise typing you will notice that you become a lot quicker.
- Some people can type without even looking at the keyboard, this is called touch typing!



Make sure you:

- Sit comfortably with your back up straight and your feet on the ground!
- Use the correct fingers
- Don't rush!
- Always rest your wrists on the desk.

A keyboard has rows of keys.
Today, we are going to practise
typing using the **HOME ROW**.

Level 1 starts with the home row keys.

In this level you will learn to type the keys on the home row as well as letters e, i, r and u.

- Stage 1: f d s a j k l ; g h
- Stage 2: e i
- Stage 3: r u

Play level 1 and click on the button to select the stage you want.
