# Learning to type quickly and accurately is an important skill.


- If you practise typing you will notice that you become a lot quicker.
- Some people can type without even looking at the keyboard, this is called touch typing!



### Make sure you:

- · Sit comfortably with your back up straight and your feet on the ground!
- · Use the correct fingers
- · Don't rush!
- · Always rest your wrists on the desk.



- Stage 1: f d s a j k l ; g h
- Stage 2: e i
- Stage 3: r u

Play level 1 and click on the button to select the stage you want.


