WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL

Dear Parents and Families

Firstly I would like to welcome everybody back to school after the long break and it really is brilliant to be back. All our batteries are fully re-charged and we are really looking forward to the year ahead.

Just to remind everyone that we start at **8.45am** every morning and the children need to arrive between 8.40 and 8.45 to ensure they are in class and ready to learn at the start of every day.

Thank you to our site and cleaning team for making the building look so good during the holiday, and to our teaching and support teams for their work to get everything ready for the new year. It was great to see everyone today and the children and staff have reacted really well to being back in school. Year leaders will also be writing to parents with details of PE days etc. and all learning plans will be uploaded to our school website [here](#).

You may have seen our new crossing and road markings in Fairisle Road, which have been installed during the holiday. Please do not bring vehicles into the road, especially during the morning and afternoon peak periods and do not park in residents' spaces in Malin Close and Orkney Close. You need to park away from the school site and use the subways and paths to reach us. Thank you for your understanding.

Mr Hayes will be contacting all families with EHCP children over the first few weeks of term to ensure that all transition plans from last year are running smoothly. Do contact him directly should you have any early concerns.

Medicines, Resources and Water

Should your child require regular, prescribed medicine to be in school please contact the school office for an administration of medicines form. These can be sent out and completed online and then you can let the office know that you will be dropping the medicines off to school.

We provide all children with a new named water bottle, which will be brought home each week to be cleaned. It is really important that the children stay hydrated during the day, especially if the warm weather continues. As we give a new school water bottle to each child, these are the only bottles that should be used in class.



The children have also been given their new planner as well as all the equipment they will need for the year. It is vital that your child reads with an adult at home and that the planner is signed and is brought into school every day.

Attendance

It is vital that the children attend school every day (subject to them feeling well enough, of course). All the usual rules on attendance continue to apply, including:

- Parents' duty to ensure that their child of compulsory school age attends regularly;
- Schools' responsibilities to record attendance and follow up absence;
- The ability to issue sanctions, including fixed penalty notices, in line with the Southampton City Council code of conduct;
- The duty on Southampton City Council to put in place arrangements for identifying, and to follow up with, children missing education.

You may also have read stories in the media regarding changes to the system of Penalty Notices issued by the city council. We will be continuing to celebrate good attendance this year, with our 'In It to Win It' days each half term. We have plans to celebrate everyone in school on certain days throughout the year. Just remember, you have to be in it to win it!

We will also continue to email trip letters to parents. These include a link to a Google Form for you to complete to give consent. You can also make payments for all school activities, trips and lunches through the secure part of our school website as well as using our contactless machine in the school office. The admin team have sent login details to all new parents. If you have mislaid your login, please contact a member of our admin team and they will resend it to you.

The entry system on the pedestrian gate on Fairisle Road is linked to both schools. The gate is closed from 9.15am until 3.05pm each day. This is for the children's safety.

The secondary transfer portal for Year 6 parents is now open and all applications for next September's Year 7 **must be made by Thursday 31st October**. Please come and speak with a member of our admin team if you need any help with making an application. Fiona MacFadyen from Southampton Schools' Admissions will be visiting our school to provide help with the secondary schools admissions process for our Year 6 parents at 1400 on Friday 13th September. Please come along if you have any questions for her.
