Personal Information: Parent/Guardian Information Sheet

This information sheet includes important information about how Saints Foundation (SFC) (we, us, our) use personal information about your child. We hope that this answers any questions you might have but if there is anything you are unsure about please contact us by email at foundation@saintsfc.co.uk or by post at St Mary's Stadium, Britannia Road, Southampton SO14 5FP

What information we collect and use

If your child interacts in some way with Saints Foundation, such as participating in an in-school intervention or extra-curricular club, we may collect the following information:

- your child's name
- your child's year group
- your child's ethnicity
- information about any disabilities your child may have
- your child's gender
- information about your child's educational or behavioural needs (so we tailor sessions as appropriate and monitor inclusion and diversity)
- your child's responses to project evaluation questionnaires (so we can understand the impact of our work and how to improve)
- information collected for safeguarding and pastoral care purposes

Why do we collect this information?

We collect this information:

- so we can deliver our activities and promote the safety and wellbeing of your child;
- so we can track, monitor and research a child's interactions with Saints Foundation so we can assess the impact we are having and areas for improvement;
- to prove to our funders (including the Premier League Charitable Fund, Comic Relief and Children in Need) that our community programmes are effective should continue to be funded so we can continue to deliver them.

Sharing information we collect

We will share the information we collect:

- where necessary for the safety or wellbeing of your child or another individual;
- with Southampton Football Club Limited where necessary to receive relevant services (as Saints Foundation receives IT, Safeguarding, Marketing, Legal and other support from Southampton FC);
- (in a way that means your child cannot be identified) with the organisations that fund our programs so that they can make sure that we are using their money suitably. For this reason, some of the funders we share the information with may also share the information with their funders. Our funders include the Premier League Charitable Fund, the Premier League, Children in Need, BT Supporter's Club and Comic Relief.

Storing information about your child

We will store information about your child only while we need it. We use a platform called Salesforce, to store information and share this (on an anonymised basis) with the Premier

League Charitable Fund. We also store information in locked cabinets on our sites and on our secure networks.

Your rights

On behalf of you or your child you can ask to see any information about you or your child that we hold, for this information to be corrected and for us to delete or stop using this information.
