TO ALL YEAR 5 PARENTS OF CHILDREN GOING TO STUBBINGTON

Dear Parents and Families,

We hope both you and your child are looking forward to our forthcoming residential to Stubbington as much as we are.

Just a few reminders:

- Please make sure your child has a warm, waterproof coat, a hat and gloves to wear during the trip as they will be outside each day;
- Children need wellington boots (or sturdy walking boots) for some activities but **must** also have a pair of trainers for other activities during the day;
- Please do not send any food in your child's bag to ensure the safety of those with allergies (there will be plenty of food and treats available for your child);
- No electronics are allowed at Stubbington, including mobile phones, smart watches and cameras (we recommend books or comics)

All other equipment is on the packing list you received before half term. **Please ensure your child's name is on all personal belongings.**

On Monday morning, please bring your child to the school office between 8.40am and 9.00am. We will register all the children and take in any medication and souvenir money at the doors. Please say goodbye to your child before they enter the hall.

On the Friday 5th, we are expected to return to school around 14:00. You will be allowed to collect your child from the coach, in the school car park, once they have been signed out by an adult.

Whilst at Stubbington, we will continue to operate according to our school behaviour policy, and we expect your child to respect the centre, staff and other pupils at all times. Poor behaviour undermines the enjoyment and the learning of the other children and staff. If your child chooses to misbehave, they will be dealt with in the same way as we do at school. Therefore, sanctions may include strikes through to loss of an activity, particularly if the child is not listening to **safety** instructions, and persistent or serious misbehaviour may result in a parent being required to pick their child up from the centre.
