Safeguarding Curriculum 2025-2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to share important information regarding our safeguarding curriculum, which is designed to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the children in our school. We believe that it is essential for you to be informed about what we, as a school, are putting in place to keep our children safe and how the topics covered contribute to a safe learning environment.

We are constantly reviewing our safeguarding curriculum to make sure we as a school are supporting the children the best way that we can. The Department for Education have recently released a revised guidance for the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education, which comes into effect on 1st September 2026. These recent changes are reflected in our updated Safeguarding Curriculum. The learning overview and progression for this curriculum is attached to this letter.

Therefore, we would like to invite you to a meeting on **Wednesday 28th January 2026 at 2:30pm**, where you will have the opportunity to learn more about our safeguarding curriculum. During this meeting, you will have the opportunity to engage with the PSHE lead and some members of the inclusion team, who will be sharing some of the resources that will be used to support the teaching and learning of these topics. Please do get in contact with your child's class teacher via the office if you think there is a unit in the safeguarding curriculum that your child may be particularly sensitive to. An example of this may be a recent bereavement in the family that you believe your child's class teacher should be aware of prior to the lessons being delivered.
