Year 5 Stubbington Study Centre Residential

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to share important information about the Year 5 residential trip to Stubbington Study Centre. We know how valuable these experiences are for our children's learning, independence and personal development, and we are committed to making the trip accessible for as many families as possible. To help reduce the overall cost for families, this year's residential will be three days rather than five and cost a total of £175.

The children will leave on the morning of Monday 23rd November and return on the afternoon of Wednesday 25th November. The children will be at school as normal on the Thursday.

To secure a place a deposit of **£80** is required by **Friday 27th February 2026**. This commits you to paying the full amount regardless of whether your child attends, so please ensure that your child is fully committed to attending. The final balance must be settled no later than 17th October 2026. Full payment must be made in order for your child to attend. You can make payments to clear the outstanding balance via the school office or SCOPAY. You can either make regular payments or pay the remaining amount at any time before the due date. The school office will send regular reminders.

If you want your child to attend, please complete the Google form and make the payment required to the school office.

We reserve the right to stop children whose behaviour is not acceptable from going. In the extremely unlikely event of this happening, the full amount will remain due. The trip needs to be viable in terms of numbers attending. In the unlikely event that the trip cannot go ahead and the school cancels, the deposit will be refunded in full.

We look forward to making this residential a memorable and enjoyable experience for all our Year 5 children.
