Welcome Back - Year 6

Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope you have had a lovely break and your children are feeling refreshed and ready for their final half term at Fairisle Junior School. We cannot believe how quickly this year has gone!

This half term, we hope that the children will make lots of happy memories before moving on. We are sure you will agree that we have lots of exciting things to look forward to this half term and it will be a half term they will never forget! We would like to politely remind you that the final balance of **£76** for all of the end of year celebrations will need to be settled by **Friday 19 June**.

Most of you have now chosen the size of hoody your child requires. If you have not done this, please contact your child's teacher as soon as possible to arrange this. When the hoodies arrive in school, and as soon as all monies have been paid, we will give them to the children so that they can start wearing them. Teachers will write the children's names on the hoodies (on the label) using a permanent pen to avoid them getting muddled. The children can wear their hoodies in school as part of their school uniform. We know that they are excited to get them!

In class, the children are continuing to impress us with the progress they are making with their writing. This half term, the children will be creating their own mythical creature as part of our 'Dragonology' unit and will producing a range of writing about it - we can't wait to see the outcomes. Being a fluent reader and developing their comprehension skills will give them the best possible start to Year 7 as they will need to read widely to access the full curriculum at Key Stage 3 and beyond. Thank you for helping your child at home. Just as reminder that we ask for the following to be recorded in order for your children to gain a star towards a reading reward:

- The title of the book they are reading
- The page numbers read
- Your signature

We're really looking forward to our forthcoming trips to Paultons Park on Tuesday 21st July and Calshot. The trip to Calshot will take place over two days (Tuesday 13th and Wednesday 14th July) and you will be notified of the day in which your child will be attending Calshot shortly after half term. We will write to you again, closer to each trip, to let you know exactly what the children need to wear and bring with them. Both of these trips are included in the £76 contribution towards all of the end of year celebrations. We know that these will be fun-filled, action-packed days for the children (and us) to enjoy. We would also like to underline that these trips are contingent on good behaviour, including wearing the correct school uniform.
